Contents of your D.I.T. Art Kit:

Caution: some materials may stain hands, clothes, or surfaces. Please be careful when opening the ink and paint in the Ziploc bag. The pigments may stain your clothes. The colors may dye your hands but will come off with regular washing. There are plastic gloves included for your use when you work with these materials directly. Each week, it will be helpful to clear a space for making and put newspaper, foil, or a drop cloth down to avoid staining any other surfaces. All materials will be introduced and discussed each week.

Included in this kit you will receive a **contents list** and a **materials list** for each project. This corresponds to the illustrated instructions, also enclosed. **Please note that some materials will be used in multiple projects.** At certain times you may need additional materials (e.g., a pair of scissors), or you may want to add other materials that you have on hand (e.g., magazine images or other pretty paper).
